- · 2 head offices: Florence and Pisa
- 62 trainees every year
- Link to University of Florence and Medical Council
- Link to undergraduate and postgraduate education
- Department autonomy

Teaching

- Teaching staff: GP trainers, only 20% of the teachers don't belong to the GP (specialists, particularly psychologists with experience in GP)
- collaboration with other Departments by shared master courses

The program

- According to Wonca Europe 2002 statement
- 3 tasks:
- To implement the European proposition to the Tuscan setting
- To stimulate relational and communicative skills
- To improve the skills to develop one's own professional plan

Specific aims of the Teaching Staff

- Homogeneity in trainers' teaching methods
- To preserve originality of every single educational experience
- To supply few notions, many models
- Autonomy of every trainee to elaborate personal models

Assessment

 Evaluation discussion between trainer and trainee at the end of the course and written dissertation to be admitted to the final examination

- ability to be enterprising
- organisational skills
